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# 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

# 1.1 About This Guide

By meeting the requirements as stipulated in the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA) Constitution and Rules, OCA Accreditation Guideline, the Host City Contract and the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 Accreditation Guide and under the authorisation of the OCA, the 2022 Hangzhou Asian Games Organising Committee (HAGOC) has formulated the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 Press Accreditation Guide (hereinafter referred to as the “Guide”). The appropriately qualified and eligible press professionals are entitled to receive an Asian Games Identity and Accreditation Card (AGIAC) which allows them to access specific Games venues and zones to perform their official functions.

The Guide contains detailed information on the accreditation process for the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 (Hangzhou 2022), including accreditation procedures, accreditation channels, issuance, and functions of AGIAC, to facilitate press professionals to go through the accreditation process. Press professionals should follow the instructions given by their respective responsible organisations and complete the relevant procedures outlined in the Guide.

To ensure that a valid Accreditation Application is submitted, please complete the Application strictly in accordance with the procedures and samples given in the Guide.

Note: The contents may be subject to COVID-19 epidemic condition.

## 1.2 Accreditation for Hangzhou 2022

Accreditation refers to the whole process of registering, producing, distributing and validating AGIAC, which displays the identification information of the holder and the rights entitled during the Games.

The purpose of accreditation is to confirm the identity and eligibility of all applicants who have submitted their applications to participate in the Games and perform their duties at the Games. AGIAC grants the holder necessary access rights and privileges to fulfill their official roles in the specified Games venues and zones during the Games. All participants of Hangzhou 2022 must have completed the accreditation process and obtained AGIACs.

AGIAC should only be used by accredited participants. Relevant organisations, departments and individuals must comply with the relevant rules and regulations set by the OCA and HAGOC. The AGIAC holders must wear the Card at all times and are only allowed to enter relevant Games venues or zones as specified in their AGIACs regarding access entitlements.

Owing to the organisational and operational needs of Hangzhou 2022, the personal information of all participants will be collected, stored, and used by HAGOC in an effort to provide adequate Games services.

In accordance with the practice of the Asian Games and the relevant provisions of Chinese laws, HAGOC will review the information submitted by all applicants for accreditation. Only those who have passed the review will be eligible for accreditation; those who fail will not be accredited.

## 1.3 Press Accreditation Policies

Please carefully read the important instructions below to complete the accreditation process as set out in the Guide for press professionals.

- HAGOC will only accept applications submitted by media organisations from the OCA-recognised Asian NOCs and Oceanian NOCs and their affiliated media organisations, as well as international news agencies and non-rights-holding broadcasters (ENRs). Any application requested by individual applicants will not be accepted.
- It is the responsibility of the NOCs (including the NOCs of Hong Kong, Macau and Chinese Taipei) to collect, complete and submit the accreditation applications for journalists and photographers from their media organisations.
- HAGOC will assist the OCA to collect, complete and submit the accreditation applications from those media organisations that are not directly managed by the NOCs, including international media organisations, IF/AF media and media organisation directly designated by the OCA.
- The eligibility verification of ENRs in Chinese Mainland, Hong Kong SAR and Macau SAR will be handled directly by HAGOC and the Host Broadcaster. The eligibility verification of ENRs from outside Chinese Mainland, Hong Kong SAR and Macau SAR will be handled directly by the OCA. Information regarding the accreditation of ENRs will be published on the official website of the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 ([www.hangzhou2022.cn](http://www.hangzhou2022.cn)) at a later date. Eligible ENRs are required to collect, complete and submit the accreditation applications to HAGOC.
- NOCs and responsible organisations need to ensure that the media organisations and individuals being accredited within their territory are genuine recognised press professionals (including journalists and photographers and non-rights-holding broadcasters). Only those persons accredited as photographers (EP, EPs and EPx) may act as photographers inside any Games venue.

- All media accreditation applications will be conducted online via the Hangzhou 2022 Online Accreditation System. Please refer to the Online Accreditation System User Manual for detailed instructions. NOCs and responsible organisations should designate one Accreditation Liaison specifically responsible for the accreditation of press professionals.



## 1.4 News Access Rules (NARs) and Undertaking

### 1.4.1 News Access Rules (NARs) and ENR Undertaking

All ENR organisations must have completed and signed the ENR Undertaking and return the document back to HAGOC Accreditation Centre by e-mail, so as to apply for the Pre-valid AGIACs. This document will be used as concrete proof that the organisation has read and understood the News Access Rules (NARs) and that every individual appointed by the organisation to cover Hangzhou 2022 has agreed to abide by the NARs applicable to the Hangzhou 2022. Infringement of these rules could lead to the withdrawal of the ENR accreditation by the OCA and HAGOC.

The NARs come into effect during Games time, and will be amended by the OCA and HAGOC from time to time at the OCA and HAGOC's sole discretion. Further information on the NARs can be found at the official website for the 19th Asian Games Hangzhou 2022 ([www.hangzhou2022.cn](http://www.hangzhou2022.cn)) when published in late 2021.

### 1.4.2 Photographers' Undertaking

All persons accredited in the photographer category (EP, EPs and EPx) must visit the service desk in the Main Media Centre (MMC) to complete and sign a Photographers' Undertaking to collect their photographer vest. Photographers will only be permitted to access photo positions with the photographer vest.

Whilst not being formally recognised as part of the accreditation process, the signing of a Photographers' Undertaking is a mandatory requirement of the accreditation process for photographers, and non-compliance with the stipulations may result in withdrawal of the accreditation.

## 1.6 Epidemic Response

The OCA has published Guidelines for the Organisation and Management of OCA Events during Covid-19 Pandemic (1st edition) on its official website in April 2021, which will be updated and distributed to NOCs according to the latest development of the pandemic.

With HAGOC advancing the Games preparation efforts, it is likely that relevant policies and procedures described in the Guide will continue to be improved, enriched, optimized and updated. NOCs and media organisations are advised to stay tuned.

HAGOC is currently formulating pandemic prevention policies and will issue the Hangzhou 2022 COVID-19 Prevention and Control Manual (Version 1.0) by March 2022, which will continue to be amended according to latest pandemic situation in due course. The policies and COVID-19 prevention and control measures to be implemented prior to and during the Games will be specified in future editions of the Guide and in the Hangzhou 2022 COVID-19 Prevention and Control Manual which will be released at a later date.

## 1.7 Glossary

Term	Definition
Accreditation	The process of registering, producing, distributing and validating Asian Games Identity and Accreditation Card (AGIAC).
Asian Games Identity and Accreditation Card (AGIAC)	A personalised card issued by HAGOC with the authorisation from the OCA. It established the identity of the holder, identifies the access rights and other privileges of the cardholder during Games time.
Accreditation Centre (AC)	A facility operated by HAGOC to provide accreditation services for the participants.
Accreditation Sub-centre	A facility operated by HAGOC in non-competition venues to provide accreditation services for the participants.
Accreditation Validated Desk	A facility operated by HAGOC to provide AGIAC validation service for the participants.
Venue Accreditation Office	A facility operated by HAGOC in competition venues to provide services such as application for and distribution of additional access pass for the participants, and solve any emergency or anomaly related to accreditation in the concerned venues.
Accreditation Application	A form for submitting accreditation information.
Badging	The process of issuing an AGIAC.
Accreditation Category	Group of accredited people based on the similarity of their functions in Hangzhou 2022, and therefore allocated similar access and other rights.
Accredited Group	A group of personnel eligible for accreditation under a specific accreditation category.

Codes	A system of letters, numbers or symbols displayed on the AGIAC that indicate a particular organisation, precinct, venue, zone or other access entitlements or standards for easy recognition by all Games participants.
Venue Access Codes	Alphabetic codes compiled by and displayed on the AGIAC that indicate access entitlements to specific venue.
Zones	Areas divided within the venue based on access entitlements and operational requirements.
Zone Codes	Codes displayed on the AGIAC that indicate designated access areas within venues.
Transport Codes	A system of letters and numbers displayed on the AGIAC that indicate the transport access of the holder.
Entitlements	Rights granted to AGIAC holders during Games time by HAGOC with the authorisation from the OCA in accordance with relevant regulations, including venue, reserved seating and transport access among others.
Quota	Limit on accreditation quantity.
Reserved Seating	Seating areas in competition venue reserved by HAGOC for designated accredited personnel in accordance with related OCA rules.
Temporary Access Pass	A kind of additional access pass. It grants necessary temporary access to the holder.
Guest Pass	A kind of additional access pass. It grants to the holder temporary access to designated non-competition venue.

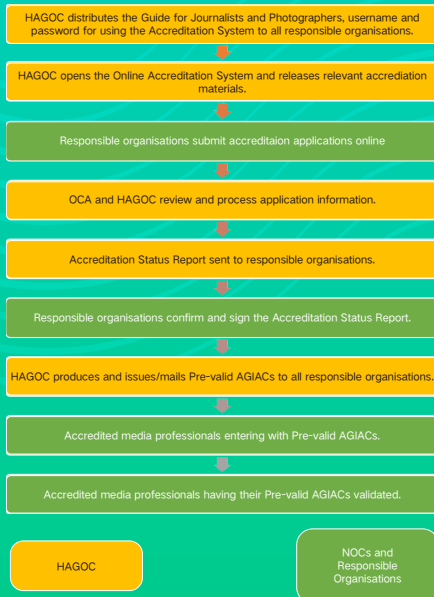
Date	Action
1-5 November 2021	HAGOC distributes Accreditation System usernames and passwords to media responsible organisations.
10 November 2021	The Accreditation System goes live. The media responsible organisations download the Accreditation Application Package.
10 April 2022	Deadline for media accreditation application.
30 April 2022	Deadline for HAGOC and responsible organisations to confirm the completeness and accuracy of media accreditation data.
10 June 2022	HAGOC distributes Pre-valid AGIACs to media responsible organisations.
11 August-10 October 2022	Non-Chinese nationals will be permitted multiple entries into and exits out of Chinese Mainland upon presentation of their valid passports (or other international travel documents) and Pre-valid AGIACs issued by HAGOC.
18 August 2022	Accreditation Sub-centre in Media Village starts to operate.
30 August 2022	Accreditation Sub-centre in Main Media Centre (MMC) starts to operate.
10 September 2022	Opening Ceremony of Hangzhou 2022
25 September 2022	Closing Ceremony of Hangzhou 2022
27 September 2022	Accreditation Sub-centres in Media Village and Main Media Centre (MMC) close.

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## 2. MEDIA ACCREDITATION PROCESS





## 2.1 Download of Accreditation Application Package

HAGOC will send the Accreditation System usernames, passwords, and other materials to media responsible organisations via official letter/e-mail from 1 to 5 November 2021. All responsible organisations are suggested to change the password after first login.

Media responsible organisations may download the Accreditation Application Package that includes all the materials related to accreditation from the Accreditation System from 10 November 2021 onward.

Responsible organisations will distribute Press Accreditation Guide, Press Accreditation Application and related instructions in filling in the applications to relevant media organisations. Press organisations will confirm the persons who will participate in the Games under the organisation and complete their Accreditation Application Forms.

## 2.2 Completion of Confirmation of Receipt Form

After downloading the Accreditation Application Package, responsible organisations shall check the content contained therein, complete the Confirmation of Receipt Form, and send an official letter or a scanned copy of the original form to HAGOC AC via e-mail.

## 2.3 Collection of Accreditation Application Information

Before completing and submitting the accreditation applications, the Accreditation Liaison of each responsible organisation shall carefully read the Guide and the documents contained in the Accreditation Application Package, and collect the personal information and photographs of all applicants within the territory of the responsible organisation in accordance with the requirements of the Guide. Details of the data field requirements of the application and specifications for the photograph can be found in Section 3 of the Guide.

## 2.4 Submission of Accreditation Application

Accreditation applications must be submitted by all responsible organisations no later than 10 April 2022. Accreditation Liaison should submit the accreditation application before the accreditation application deadline. There are two options for submitting accreditation applications, and it is up to each responsible organisation to decide the submission method that best suits its need.

- Online Accreditation: Responsible organisations can submit individual applications one at a time directly into the system.
- Online Accreditation (Bulk Upload): The Online Application (Bulk Upload) page provides the function to upload applications in batches. For information items, the system provides the function to upload Zip file.
- For more detailed information, please refer to the Online Accreditation System User Manual.
- The deadline for accreditation applications for the Hangzhou 2022 is 24:00 on 10 April 2022. In principle, HAGOC will not accept any new accreditation applications after the accreditation application deadline.

## 2.5 Verification of Accreditation Application

HAGOC will send the Accreditation Status Report to the responsible organisations that have completed and submitted the accreditation applications before the accreditation application deadline. The Accreditation Status Report contains the applicants' personal information, category, function, accreditation number and other access entitlements and privileges etc.

Responsible Organisations need to return the confirmed Accreditation Status Report by official letter or email to the Accreditation Centre of HAGOC before 30 April 2022. A Correction Sheet will be provided along with the Accreditation Status Report. In case of any correction needed, responsible organisations can amend the information in the Correction Sheet directly. The Accreditation Status Report shall be signed by the President /Secretary General / authorised representative of the responsible organisation, and affixed with the official seal of the organisation.

Responsible organisations need to return the verified Accreditation Status Report no later than 30 April 2022. Failure to return the document in time may result in delays in receiving AGIACs.

## 2.6 Modification of Accreditation Application

If the accreditation information needs to be revised after the accreditation deadline, the responsible organisation should use its official email to notify HAGOC Accreditation Centre to permit the change via mail or fax. After approval, HAGOC Accreditation Centre will access the Accreditation System to complete the revision.

## 2.7 Production and Issuance of Pre-valid AGIACs

After responsible organisations return their Accreditation Status Reports, Pre-valid AGIACs will be produced by HAGOC for those applicants whose complete applications have been received before the deadline.

Pre-valid AGIACs for applications will be sent and posted by HAGOC, upon receiving the Accreditation Status Reports, to the NOCs and media organisations that have completed the accreditation process on time.



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# 3. INSTRUCTIONS ON FILLING IN ACCREDITATION APPLICATION





### 3) Preferred Family Name

Optional item.

The family name that an applicant wishes to display on the AGIAC when it is different from the family name indicated on the identity document. The item shall not be longer than 25 characters.

### 4) Preferred Given Name

Optional item.

The given name that an applicant wishes to display on the AGIAC when it is different from the given name indicated on the identity document. The item shall not be longer than 25 characters.

### 5) Family Name in Chinese Characters

Mandatory for applicants from Chinese Mainland.

The family name shall be the same as indicated on the identity document.

The item shall not be longer than 25 characters.

E.g. 张

### 6) Given Name in Chinese Characters

Mandatory for applicants from Chinese Mainland.

The given name shall be the same as indicated on the identity document.

The item shall not be longer than 25 characters.

E.g. 三

### 7) Nationality (country/region)

Mandatory item.

Select from the drop-down list the nationality (country/region) as indicated on the identity document.

E.g. People's Republic of China

8) Gender

Mandatory item.

Select gender from the drop-down list.

E.g. Male

9) Date of Birth

Mandatory item.

Enter the date of birth as indicated on the identity document.

E.g.1990-10-10

10) Country/Region of Birth

Mandatory item.

Select from the drop-down list the country/region of birth.

E.g. People's Republic of China

11) Registered Permanent Residence

Mandatory item.

Select from the drop-down list the country/region.

Chinese Resident Identity Card (applicable for applicants from Chinese Mainland)  
Mainland Travel Permit for Taiwan Residents (applicable for applicants from Taiwan)

Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents (applicable for applicants from residents in Hong Kong SAR and Macau SAR, China)

Residence Permit for Hong Kong and Macau Residents (applicable for applicants from residents in Hong Kong SAR and Macau SAR, China)

Mandatory item.

The number shall be the same as indicated on the identity document.

Note: Applicants from Chinese Mainland whose identity cards are permanent shall enter 31 December 2040.

Mandatory item.

HAGOC only accepts accreditation applications from responsible organisations that are recognised by the OCA. Accreditation applications from individuals or other organisations will not be accepted.

Mandatory item.

Enter the actual employer (applicable for non-media accreditation categories)/-media (applicable for applicants from media)

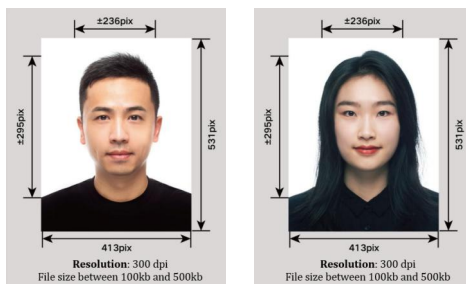

## 3.2 Photograph Requirements

No.	AGIAC Photograph Requirements
1	An easy-to-identify colour photograph taken within the last six months;
2	Plain white background, with outfit colours in stark contrast with the background;
3	The applicant must not wear any hats, scarves, hair bands, or sunglasses when taking the photograph (except for religious or medical reasons);
4	The applicant must look at the camera directly and make sure his or her eyes are visible; side-view photographs are not allowed;
5	The photograph must be clear, intact, and stainless and must not be edited;
6	Format: .jpg; Size: 413 pixels (width) and 531 pixels (height); Resolution: 300dpi (pixel/inch); File Size: 100-500KB;
7	If the photograph is submitted separately from the application form, the photograph file must be named in the format of “Family name_Given name (in capital letter)_identity document number” . Correct example 1: ZHANG_SAN_31033219810302343 Correct example 2: GREEN_JACK_PSH0458712

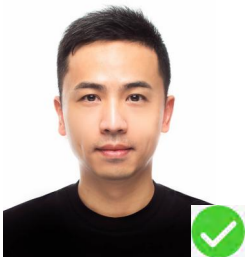

### 3.3 Alternatives of Non-Standard English Letters

Participants from non-English speaking countries may have names that contain non-standard English letters that are not recognised by the Accreditation System of Hangzhou 2022. These characters cannot be entered into the Accreditation System, thus they need to be replaced by similar-looking English letters.

## 3.4 Name Abbreviation Rules

Due to the character length limit on the AGIAC, family name and given name can be printed with a maximum of 25 characters each (including spaces). If the length of the family name or given name exceeds 25 characters, the system will omit or shorten the holder's family name or given name to within 25 characters. In this case, only the first 25 characters of both the holder's family name and given name will be printed, and the remainder will not be displayed on the AGIAC.

Example 1: Assume the holder's family name is DOS SANTOS GONCALVES CORREIA (28 characters in total) and given name is MARIA DO CARMO (less than 25 characters), then the name printed on the AGIAC will be MARIA DO CARMO DOS SANTOS GONCALVES CORR. The part after the 25th place in the family name, in this case "EIA", is omitted.

Example 2: Suppose the holder's family name is KATTIMATHARI SARI BAKALINATIN (more than 25 characters) and the given name is PUTTUTHAMADILIKA MARIDISRALI (more than 25 characters). The name shown on the AGIAC will be PUTTUTHAMADILIKA MARIDISR KATTIMATHARI SARI BAKALIN. The parts after the 25th place in both the family name and given name are omitted.





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# 4. ASIAN GAMES IDENTITY AND ACCREDITATION CARD (AGIAC)

## 4.1 AGIAC Functions

The OCA owns the Asian Games Identity and Accreditation Card (AGIAC), and has the right to decide the issuance and withdrawal of AGIACs at any time. The OCA determines who are eligible for holding AGIACs, and stipulates conditions for the approval and issuance of AGIACs. With authorisation from the OCA, HAGOC produces and manages AGIACs for Hangzhou 2022, and distributes them to those who have completed accreditation applications.

Functions of AGIAC:

- AGIAC holders may access Games venues and zones to perform their duties or participate in activities, and enjoy necessary access entitlements;
- Non-Chinese nationals will be permitted multiple entries into and exits out of Chinese Mainland upon presentation of their valid passports (or other international travel documents) and AGIACs issued by HAGOC from 00:00, 11 August 2022 to 24:00, 10 October 2022 (Beijing Time, GMT+8).

\*Policies on AGIACs for Hangzhou 2022 may be subject to change when future COVID-19 prevention and control requirements call for such changes.

## 4.2 Valid Period

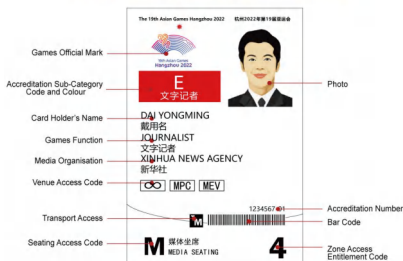
The AGIACs will be valid from 00:00, 11 August 2022 to 24:00, 10 October 2022 (Beijing Time, GMT+8).

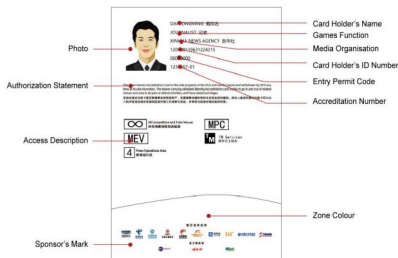

## 4.4 AGIACs Validation

AGIACs should be validated at designated accreditation facilities. For details on accreditation facilities, please refer to Section 6 of the Guide.

Only validated AGIACs are effective official pass for Hangzhou 2022 and guarantee the holders access and service privileges that match their accreditation status.

An AGIAC could not be validated if its holder's information in the Accreditation System is inconsistent with that on his/her valid identity document. In this case, the card holder shall report to his/her responsible organisation, re-submit his/her accreditation information and obtain a new AGIAC in accordance with accreditation policies and procedures. The card holder shall take the responsibilities arising therefrom.

## 4.5 Special Cases

### 4.5.1 Loss or Damage of Pre-valid AGIACs Before Entering Chinese Mainland

If a Pre-valid AGIAC is lost or damaged before its holder enters Chinese Mainland, the holder shall immediately notify his/her responsible organisation, which shall then notify HAGOC in writing.

HAGOC will cancel the lost or damaged Pre-valid AGIAC in the Accreditation System. Cancelled AGIACs cannot be validated again.

Meanwhile, the applicant will have to obtain, on his/her own, a visa or other entry-exit documents for entry into Chinese Mainland. HAGOC will provide necessary assistance. After entry, the applicant can go to Accreditation Sub-centre in the MMC to apply for a new AGIAC.

### 4.5.2 Loss or Damage of AGIACs

If a validated AGIAC is lost or damaged, its holder shall immediately notify his/her responsible organisation, which shall then notify HAGOC in writing. The AGIAC concerned cannot be validated again.

MMC Accreditation Sub-centre can issue a new card only after receiving an applicant's AGIAC reissuance application form signed and stamped by his/her responsible organisation. Before the new AGIAC is issued, the card holder must return the damaged AGIAC to MMC Accreditation Sub-centre.

### 4.5.3 Collection of AGIACs After Entering Chinese Mainland

For non-Chinese applicants who submit their accreditation application after the deadline, HAGOC cannot guarantee that they can receive their AGIACs before their departures for Chinese Mainland. Therefore, they have to obtain a visa or other entry-exit documents by themselves. After entering Chinese Mainland, they may collect and validate their AGIACs at MMC Accreditation Sub-centre by presenting the valid identity documents they used for accreditation applications.

#### 4.5.4 Reproduction of New AGIACs

Under special circumstance where a new AGIAC is needed, the card holder shall immediately notify his/her responsible organisation, which shall then notify HAGOC in writing. MMC Accreditation Sub-centre can only issue a new card after HAGOC's confirmation. Only after the card holder returns the original AGIAC to MMC Accreditation Sub-centre, will the new AGIAC be reproduced.

## 4.6 Entering Chinese Mainland with AGIACs

Non-Chinese nationals will be permitted multiple entries into and exits out of Chinese Mainland upon presentation of their valid passports (or other international travel documents) and AGIACs issued by HAGOC from 00:00, 11 August 2022 to 24:00, 10 October 2022 (Beijing Time, GMT +8).

When entering into the Chinese Mainland with AGIACs, card holders shall make sure that the information on their valid passports (or other international travel documents) is the same as indicated on the identity documents used for accreditation applications, and the expiry date of the concerned documents shall be no earlier than 31 December 2022.

Should card holders renew their passports (or other international travel documents) before entering Chinese Mainland, thereby causing inconsistency with the visa information on AGIACs, the concerned responsible organisations shall inform HAGOC of the case. HAGOC will provide support in their entry into Chinese Mainland based on the actual situation. Meanwhile, the card holders shall bring their identity documents used for accreditation applications when entering Chinese Mainland.

In case card holders lose the identity documents used for accreditation applications before entering Chinese Mainland, the concerned responsible organisations shall inform HAGOC of the case, and provide HAGOC with the information of the new passports (or other international travel documents). HAGOC will provide support in their entry into Chinese Mainland based on the actual situation.





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## 5. ADDITIONAL ACCESS PASS

Additional Access Pass refers to Games access pass used for temporary venue access by accredited or non-accredited personnel during Games time.

Additional Access Passes include Temporary Access Pass, Athletes Village Guest Pass and MPC Guest Pass, and IBC Guest Pass.

## 5.1 Temporary Access Pass

Temporary Access Pass is applicable for accredited or non-accredited personnel that need temporary access to competition venues and training venues to perform their duties.

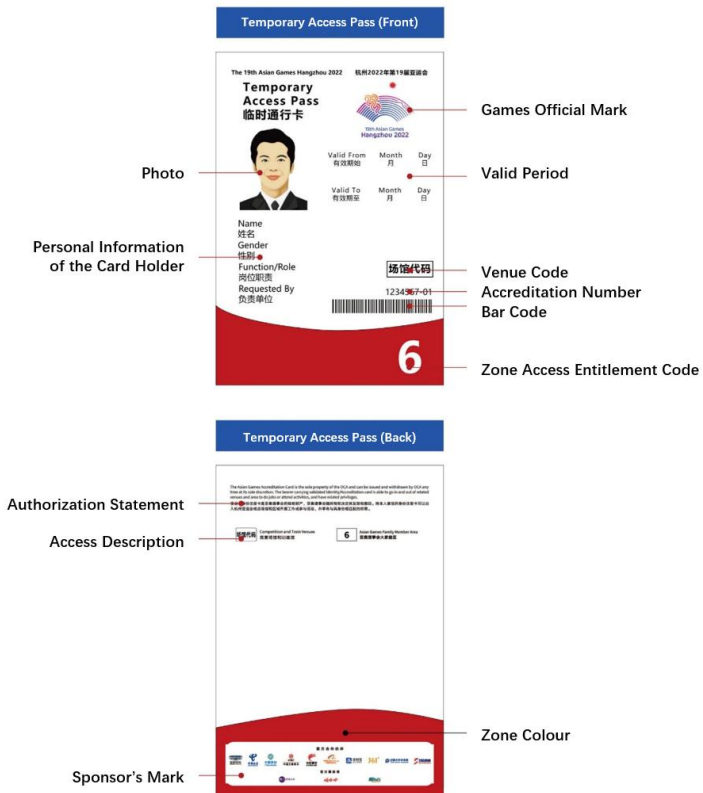
Accredited press professionals can apply for Temporary Access Pass only when his or her AGIAC is lost or damaged, and the new AGIAC is under re-issuance. The Temporary Access Pass shall not expand access entitlements of the accredited personnel. Accredited personnel with access to reserved seating can have corresponding access entitlements with the Temporary Access Passes.

In principle, the Temporary Access Pass is only valid within the day of collection.

### Application Process

Phase	Description
1	The responsible organisation submits application via the Accreditation System;
2	For non-accredited applicant, the responsible organisation shall submit the application by 12:00 the day before the pass is to be used; For accredited applicant, the responsible organisation shall submit the application by 18:00 the day before the pass is to be used;
3	After confirming the application approval in the Accreditation System, the responsible organisation shall inform the applicant to collect the pass at designated accreditation facilities with valid identity documents.

## 5.2 Guest Pass

Guest Pass is applicable for temporary access to the Athletes Village, MPC and IBC.

\*Policies on guest pass may be subject to change when future COVID-19 prevention and control requirements call for such changes.

### 5.2.1 Athletes Village Press Guest Pass

Press professionals may collect a Guest Pass with their valid identity documents with photos (such as passport and AGIAC) at the Athletes Village Media Centre. To protect the privacy and safety of village residents, only those who need to perform their duties in the Athletes Village are granted access to enter with such documents.

#### Application Process

Phase	Description
1	Applicants who need to enter the International Zone of the Athletes Village for work purposes should submit a Guest Pass application 24 hours in advance to the Athletes Village Media Centre, from where the application will be forwarded to the Athletes Village Accreditation Sub-centre.
2	The Athletes Village Accreditation Sub-centre produces Guest Passes that have been approved by the venue manager.

Phase	Description
3	Applicants arriving at the Athletes Village must first go to the Athletes Village Media Centre and present their valid identity document in exchange for a Guest Pass.
4	Guests should return the Guest Passes to take back their valid identity documents when leaving.

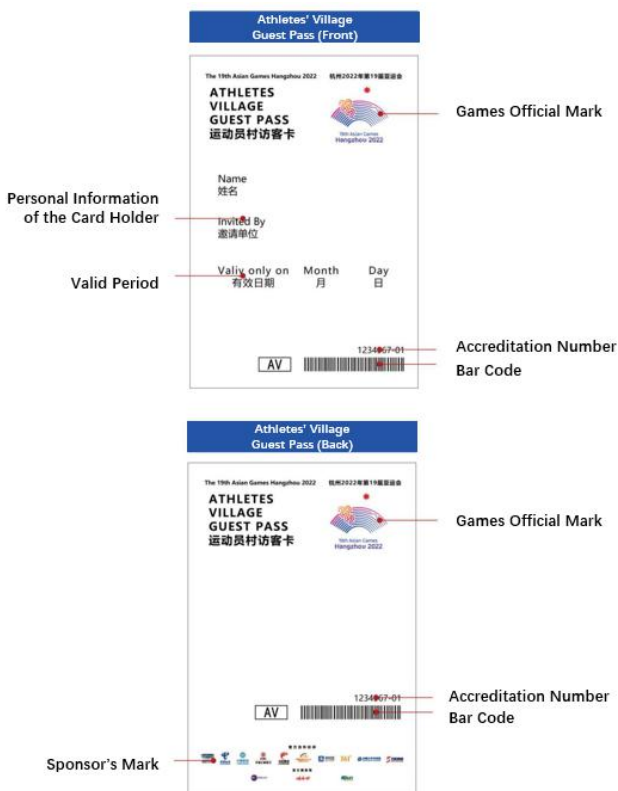
### Rules and Regulations

Access of press professionals in the Athletes Village is limited to the International Zone. Press professionals may interview athletes and experience their lives in the International Zone of the Athletes Village.

For press professionals, access to the Residential Zone is strictly controlled and will only be granted to those who comply with the following rules and requirements:

- A written invitation from the NOC, signed by the Chef de Mission.
- Availability of the NOC's quota for Athletes Village Guest Pass.
- An NOC delegation member must be present throughout the visit.
- Taking photos or shooting videos is not allowed in any public area of the Residential Zone, except in NOC-designated places.
- It is the responsibility of the concerned NOC to ensure their invited guests' full compliance with the regulations during their visits and bear all consequences arising therefrom.

Example: Athletes Village Guest Pass (Image)



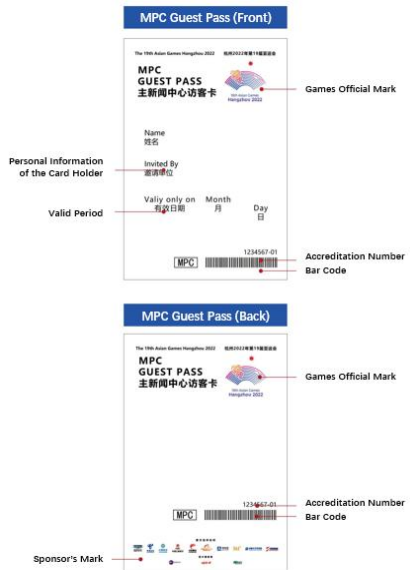
### 5.2.2 MPC Guest Pass

HAGOC can issue MPC Guest Passes to guests invited by accredited media or other guests.

#### Application Process

Phase	Description
1	The concerned responsible organisation submits a Guest Pass application via the Accreditation System by 16:00 the day before the scheduled visit;
2	Guests arrive at the Accreditation Sub-centre and collect their Guest Passes with their valid ID documents;
3	Guests return the Guest Passes and retrieve their identity documents before they leave the MPC.

#### Example: MPC Guest Pass (Image)



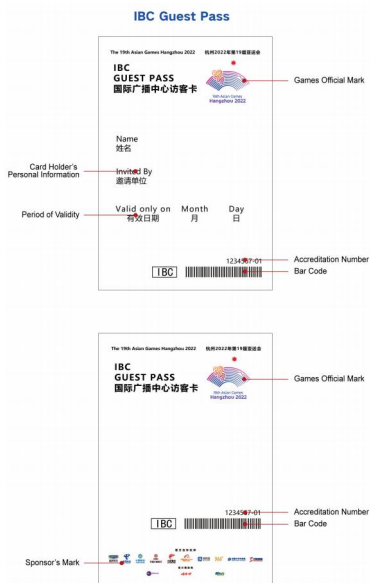
### 5.2.3 IBC Guest Pass

IBC Guest Pass is managed and issued by the Host Broadcaster, and the application process is the same as that for MPC Guest Pass.

#### Application Process

Phase	Description
1	The concerned responsible organisation submits a Guest Pass application via the Accreditation System by 16:00 the day before the scheduled visit;
2	Guests arrive at the Accreditation Sub-centre and collect their Guest Passes with their valid ID documents; The guests must be accompanied by accredited personnel who have the IBC access entitlement throughout their visits;
3	Guests return the Guest Passes and retrieve their identity documents before they leave the IBC.

## 5.3 Supplementary Access Control Devices (SACDs)

The AGIAC does not entitle press professionals to access to all event coverage or to all areas within Zone 4.

For some special areas, such as Photographer stand and Field of Play, HAGOC may adopt supplementary access control devices, such as tickets, passes, armbands or vests. More details can be found in the 19th Asian Games 2022 Hangzhou Media Guide and the 19th Asian Games 2022 Hangzhou Photographer Guide.



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# 6. ACCREDITATION FACILITIES AND SERVICES

## 6.1 Accreditation Sub-centres and Accreditation Validation Desks

During Hangzhou 2022, HAGOC will set up seven accreditation sub-centres, one accreditation validation desk at the official port of entry (Hangzhou International Airport) and one accreditation validation desk at the transport hub (Hangzhoudong Railway Station). Accreditation Sub-centres offer services including AGIAC validation, inquiry services, and on-site AGIAC and other additional access passes production. Accreditation validation desks only provide AGIAC validation services.
