



OLYMPIC COUNCIL OF ASIA

Decisions of the 46th OCA General Assembly
Tashkent, Uzbekistan – 26th January 2026

1. All the 45 Member NOCs attended the 46th OCA General Assembly held in Tashkent on 26th January 2026
2. The welcome address and the report of Acting President OCA Mr. Timothy Fok was unanimously approved by the house.
3. The Video Address of President IOC was received with appreciation by the house, and the house unanimously expressed its gratitude to the President IOC and the IOC Administration for their support rendered to the Olympic Movement in OCA.
4. Acting President OCA Mr. Fok presented the OCA Merit Award to Dr. Hafizullah Wali Rahimi, President Afghanistan Olympic Association for his outstanding contribution to the development of Olympic Movement in Afghanistan and promoting women's participation in sports in Afghanistan.
5. The Host City Contract for hosting the 2029 Asian Youth Games in Tashkent, Uzbekistan was signed between the OCA represented by Mr. Timothy Fok Acting President OCA, the City of Tashkent, represented by Mr. Shavkat Umurzakov Mayor of Tashkent and the NOC of Uzbekistan represented by Mr. Otabek Umarov, First Vice President.
6. The Host City Contract for hosting the 2031 Asian Youth Games in Phnom Penh, Cambodia was signed between the OCA represented by Mr. Timothy Fok Acting President OCA, the City of Phnom Penh represented by Mr. Seng Vannak, Deputy Governor and the NOC of Cambodia represented by Mr. Vath Chamroeun, Secretary General.
7. The minutes of the 45th OCA General Assembly held in Kuwait on 11th & 12th of May 2025 were unanimously approved by the house.
8. The reports of the Vice Presidents, as circulated, were unanimously approved by the house.

9. The report of Mr. Witold Banka, President WADA was received with appreciation by the house.
10. The final report of the 9th Asian Winter Games held in Harbin from 7th to 14th of February 2025 as presented by Ms. Zhang Haihua, Dy. Secretary General of HAWGOC and Vice Mayor of Harbin City was received with appreciation by the house.
11. The Reports of Mr. Song Luzeng, Vice President OCA as well as the Sanya 2026 Asian Beach Games Organizing Committee were received with appreciation by the house.
12. Reports of Mr. Tsunekazu Takeda, Mr. Satoshi Murate Secretary General of AINAGOC as well as Mr. Mohd. Tayyab Ikram Chair of CC were received with appreciation by the house. The Coordination Committee to discuss the separation of Snatch and Clean & Jerk medals in weightlifting with the International Weightlifting Federation.
13. The report of Riyadh Asian Indoor and Martial Art Games as presented by Ms. Moonerah Al-Sudairy was received with appreciation by the house and the house unanimously requested RAIMAGOC to consider: -
 - i) inclusion of Chess, Xingqi, Go (Weiqi), Bridge – 2 events each in the sports program and also include Speed Cubing as an exhibition event.
 - ii) increase the MMA events from 6 to 18
14. RAIMAGOC will study the request and notify its decision to OCA.
15. The update on the IOC and Olympic Solidarity as well as the NOC Relations activities as presented by Mr. James Macleod Director OS was received with appreciation by the house.
16. The update on the ANOC General Assembly as presented by Mr. Kenneth Fok, Vice President NOC of Hongkong, China and by Mrs. Gunilla Lindberg, Secretary General ANOC, was received with appreciation by the house. The General Assembly also unanimously authorized the incoming President of OCA to nominate the Asia (OCA) candidates for the ANOC Executive Board 2026-2028. The General Assembly also approved the following representatives for ANOC Committees: -

- i) HRH Prince Feisal Al Husain – Chair Gender Equity Committee
- ii) Mr. Timothy Fok – Chair ANOC Events Committee
- iii) Dr. Abdulla Al-Hayyan – Member of the Executive Board ICAS

17. The house unanimously approved the: -

- i) The reports of the Standing Committees as circulated.
- ii) Endorsed and approved the Finance Committee Report, the Audit & Risk Committee Report, the Audited Consolidated Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December 2025, the Internal & External Audit Report, and the Investment Policy Framework, and Master’s Degree Program as proposed. The house also commended OCA Management and the Finance Department for their continued strong financial governance and performance. The house also unanimously approved the appointment of Grant Thornton as External Auditors and Kreston as Internal Auditors.
- iii) Amendments to the OCA Constitution & By-laws as circulated.
- iv) The proposal of the Athletes Committee, as Circulated.

17. The house unanimously approved the proposal of NOC of Qatar to host the 47th OCA General Assembly in Doha in 2027.

18. The names of the following 3 Scrutineers as proposed by Chair of the Election Committee were unanimously approved by the house: -

- i) Mr. Mohd. Younus Popalzaye – Secretary General NOC of Afghanistan
- ii) Mr. Alimzan Akayev – Secretary General NOC of Kazakhstan
- iii) Ms. Lisa Hsu Hsiao Tzu – Secretary General of NOC of Chinese Taipei

19. H.E. Sheikh Joaan Bin Hamad Al-Thani was elected as President of OCA with 44 votes and one vote being invalid.

20. The newly elected President OCA thanked the house for their support and stated that he will strive to promote Asian Unity through sports, empower Asian athletes as the heart of our movement, to support good governance and to ensure sustainable development for all sports across Asia.
