

Ethical Guidelines for attending OCA Meetings

- 1. The NOCs and their delegates are bound by the OCA Constitution/Olympic Charter and the OCA/IOC Ethics Code.
- 2. The NOCs are responsible for the act and behaviour of their respective delegates.
- 3. The NOCs and its delegates must act and speak respecting the Chair and General Assembly and in the spirit of a good sportsperson behaviour.
- 4. Delegate will raise their hands if they wish to speak. They will speak with permission from the Chair.
- 5. Delegate will speak on a particular topic only once and for not more than 2-minute duration. The Chair has the authority to extend the time limit.
- 6. Delegate will always be seated on his/her Chair and will speak from his/her Chair. Delegates are not allowed to come to the main Dias or speak out of turn or mute the mics of other delegates.
- 7. Any delegate trying to speak out of his/her turn or without the permission of the Chair or trying to create pandemonium in the Assembly Hall will be asked to leave the GA Hall and will be referred to the OCA/IOC Ethics

 Committee for further action.
- 8. Only the accredited delegates nominated by their respective NOCs and accredited invitees will be allowed to enter the hall of the General Assembly, both physically or virtually.
- 9. If anything, not included in this set of guidelines is warranted to be done to maintain decorum of the proceedings, the decision of the Chair will be final and binding.
